

Mr. Karol Półtorak is a graduate of the Warsaw School of Economics and University of Derby. He has been connected with the domestic capital market since 1999. Since 1997 he has had a license of a securities broker.

From 2014 to March 2016 he served as Vice President of the Warsaw Stock Exchange, where he was responsible, among others, for finance. Then, he also worked as a member of the supervisory board of the National Depository for Securities, the Chairman of the Supervisory Board KDPW_CCP, a member of the Supervisory Board of Stock Exchange Centre and Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the Warsaw Stock Exchange Services Centre.

Previously, in 2011-2014 he worked for the Citi Group as Management Board's Vice President of Brokerage House of Citi Bank Handlowy. Being the head of the Office of Capital Operations, he carried out transactions of raising capital for companies listed on the Warsaw Stock Exchange and their shareholders (IPOs, pre-IPO, accelerated equity offerings, follow-on, dual-listings, equity-linked), cooperating with national and foreign investors and issuers.
